

**BEDALE & WEST OF YORE HUNTS P.C- MAIN CAMP
EQUIPMENT LIST – CHILD.**

PLEASE NO DUVETS, DIVANS OR LILOS.

1 Camp bed with legs (no lilos, divans or mattresses) we recommend the Steel Easy Bed (FN6113) from Yeoman's.
1 Winter sleeping bag, pillow, blankets and a survival bag from Yeoman's.
1 Waterproof box or suitcase to keep everything in.
1 Ground sheet.
Picnic chair.
Washing bowl and tooth mug.
Torch with spare batteries, please not a key ring torch.
Water bottle for the night.
Dining equipment (plate, mug with handle for hot drinks, knife, fork and spoon – all named and brought in a draw string bag).
1 Pair of waterproof trousers.
1 Pair of Wellington boots.
1 Waterproof coat not an anorak.
3 Complete changes of clothes + clothes suitable for Friday night disco.
Warm jumper for the evenings.
B&WY sweatshirt / t shirt if you have one.
2/3 Pairs of jodhpurs/breeches, cream to be worn in the morning for parade.
2 White shirts with collars (minimum)
Pony club tie and badge.
Riding Jacket.
Body Protector –we recommend the current level 3 Cross Country Body Protector.
Riding Hat – to conform to Pony Club regulations.
Riding cane /whip.
Riding Boots.
Riding Gloves.
Hair nets (essential for girls with anything but very short hair).
Underwear.
Warm pyjamas.
Sponge bag.
Towel.
Trainers.
Swim wear and towel, goggles etc.
Black bin liner for dirty or wet clothes.
Small amount of money (can be left with camp Mum).
Any prescribed medication (can be left with Vanessa Brewis).
Sun Cream.
Sun Hat.
Pony Club Manual of Horsemanship.
Children may bring a bike.

HELPFUL HINTS.

Belongings are kept drier if stored in a plastic box (e.g. stacker box) rather than a suitcase.
Some bailer twine and a hanger is useful for smart clothes, a plastic cover is also useful.
