

B&WY P.C. MAIN CAMP EQUIPMENT LIST – PONY.

The following **MUST** be brought by each member attending Camp – **CLEARLY NAMED**.

Horse/pony – over 5yrs old, recently shod.
Saddle and bridle.
2 head collars in good repair, with halter rope in good repair.
Hay net.
Grooming kit (as listed in the Manual of Horsemanship).
Large sponge and scraper.
Tail bandage.
Fly repellent.
2 large (5 gallon) water buckets and 1 smaller one for topping up.
1 feed bucket.

1 wheelbarrow.
1 rake **MUST BE PLASTIC**.
1 shovel.
1 skip e.g. plastic washing basket.
Hard feed.
Plastic bin for soaking hay if required.
Shavings if straw is not suitable.
Haylage if hay is not suitable.

HELPFUL HINTS.

Plastic boxes are useful for horse gear and provide good protection if the weather is wet.

Tyres are useful to hold the water buckets upright in the stables.

EVERYTHING MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED.

IF TACK IS NOT NAMED THERE WILL BE A CHARGE OF 30p MADE FOR EACH TAG NEEDED.
